WHAT?

WHEN? Application **deadline is Feb. 17, 2017.**

Applicants will be notified of final decisions by Apr. 14, 2017.

HOW MUCH? Each fellowship carries an \$8,000 stipend.

WHO CAN APPLY?

DOES THIS IMPACT OTHER SU GRAD FUNDING?

No. The fellowships are administered through the New York Council for the Humanities and do not impact eligibility for other funding/support from Syracuse University.

REQUIREMENTS:

In addition to working toward a proposed public humanities project, fellows must attend a two-day orientation in New York City **August 21 and 22, 2017**. Fellows must also participate in webinars and workshops throughout the year, and attend The Fellow will participate in workshops scheduled for **December 2017** and **June 2018** (see full call for proposals).
