The Geography Department is pleased to announce the launch of a new initiative – the SU Map Shop. Across campus, there is growing interest in spatial data, data visualization, spatial analysis, and mapping techniques. The SU Map Shop is an effort to make the resources and techniques of geographic research available to our campus. The SU Map Shop will offer mapping/GIS assistance related to spatial data, analysis, and design to faculty and students across campus.

- **Weekly consultation hours with Joe Stoll, cartographer.** Joe can work with students and faculty interested in creating maps or other visual representations for their research or projects.
- **Weekly consultation hours with John Olson, Geography/GIS librarian.** John can help students and faculty interested in learning more about geospatial data, geo-resources from the SU Library, and GIS software.
- **Workshops and sessions on data visualization, map design, and other aspects of locating and using geographic resources and analysis.** These sessions can be incorporated into existing courses or offered through one of the Geography Department's spatial analysis labs.**
