Conventional approaches to filmmaking and scholarship persist in marginalizing communities that are already on the margins and marked as different. Rooted in the idea that knowledge is embedded social relations and lived experience, research justice demands that we no longer do research and scholarship as if communities do not matter.

This filmmaking as scholarship workshop explores conversations and techniques as part of the larger toolkit for research justice.

Workshop participants will learn a filmic-research praxis that disrupts archetypical representations that misrepresent and are reductive and extractive of people and communities that we should hold dear.
